Compliance codes are embedded in the media which students have to write down because they can be requested as part of the testing that is a requirement for the certificate. Students must pass a test at 80 percent accuracy or better to earn a certificate. Questions on the test are very specific to course content and are difficult to "guess" or "fudge." Certificates are archived. Referral sources can request an "authenticity check" to see if a certificate that is presented is authentic (i.e. archived on the site as opposed to re-created with a word processor).

Cost: Access to all content is free. Testing and certificate generation is \$99. This includes certificates for all programs offered on the site. <u>Pro bono</u> memberships are available with a request made directly from a judge or *qualified referral source."

Other Courses Offered (those marked with an * are starting October 2009): Parenting, *parenting during and after divorce (also called co-parenting), dealing with difficult teens.
